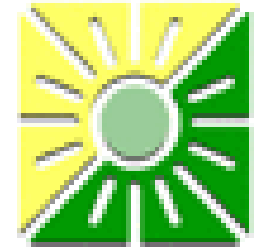
We are passionate about what we do. We will "give them fish a few times" but then "we teach them to fish." We help the Poor help themselves.

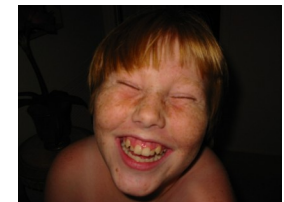

Phoenix Children's Project is dedicated to improving the lives of children living in poverty in Phoenix, AZ and it's surrounding areas. Our goal is to help these children become healthy, self-reliant adults. First we assist them with food and clothing, then we teach them how to help themselves so they can "break the chain" and create better lives for themselves as adults.

WHO WE HELP

We help children living below poverty level in the Metro Phoenix area. Most of these children live in government housing and come from households with a total annual income of less than \$9,000. They are well loved and happy children.

- Children ages range from 0-16 years,
- Most come from single-parent homes with four or more siblings,
- If a male figure lives in the household, he is required to work,
- There are no illegal drugs allowed and our no-drugs tolerance is strictly enforced,
- We ask our families to volunteer their time and they gladly want to give back.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

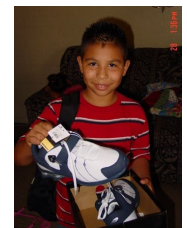
Help of any kind is appreciated and needed! Our volunteers go the extra mile to make a difference. Some examples include:
